Uniform Expectation

This includes keeping shirts tucked in, buttons fastened, and ensuring there are no rips, holes, or tears. Uniforms should be free from writing, excessive paint or grease, and boots must be polished.

Students are required to wear the approved uniform for their specific section.

If a student's uniform does not meet these standards, parents will be notified, and new items will need to be purchased to maintain the high standards and image of the College community.

Afterhours

Town Trips

During the week, students must wear the classroom uniform and maintain a presentable appearance when going into town.

At All Other Times

Neat casual clothing is required within the Residence.

Dining Room

Students must wear appropriate footwear, keep their hair neat and tied back off the face and collar or under a hair net, and remove hats.

Clothing should not feature offensive designs, and singlets, strappy or strapless tops, or dirty work clothes are not allowed. Boots are also not permitted to be worn in the dining room.

Students will be asked to change if their clothing is deemed inappropriate by the Residential staff.

Laundry Number

Each new student will receive a unique laundry number that they will keep throughout their time at the College.

Please ensure that all clothing items, including both school uniforms and personal clothes, as well as sheets, towels, and other fabrics, are labelled with this assigned laundry number.



BYODBring Your Own Device



What is BYOD? BYOD (Bring Your Own Device) refers to students bringing a personally owned device to school for the purpose of learning.

WA College of Agriculture - Harvey recognises the need to prepare students for a rapidly changing world where technology plays an increasing role in students' everyday lives.

What devices can students bring to school?

Students can bring devices to school that follow the required device specifications. These specifications mean that the device will be

- Easily connected to the school WiFi.
- They will provide access to a common software and application platform.
- They will allow students access to a personal device they can take home.

Carry Bag/Protection
External Hard Drive (minimum 1 TB)

General Information

Parents may choose to purchase a device from any source however, only devices with the specifications outlined will be able to be used in the school

Student and Family Responsibility

In the BYOD program, students and parents must:

- Sign the BYOD Student Agreement before bringing their devices to school.
- Ensure their devices are safe and secure at all times.
- The School is unable to accept responsibility for lost, damaged or stolen devices.

Misuse of Device During School Hours

Internet access on the device will be filtered at school and students will be prohibited from connecting to other networks while at school. Students will comply with the Department of Education (DoE) and school policies concerning using BYODs at school and while connected to the DoE network.

BYODBring Your Own Device



Technical Support

WA College of Agriculture - Harvey staff are under no obligation to provide any technical support on either hardware or software.

The College does have an IT member available to assist students where possible during the week.

Long-term care and support of BYODs.

- Students are solely responsible for the repair and maintenance of their own devices. It is not the school's responsibility.
- Warranties: Students should understand the limitations of the manufacturer's warranty on their BYOD, both in duration and in coverage. Under Australian consumer legislation, warranties usually last for one year. During this period any manufacturing defects will be repaired or the device will be replaced (as per the specific terms and conditions of the manufacturer).
- Extended warranties: At the time of purchase, students may also purchase an optional extended warranty (past the standard warranty period) from the supplier/manufacturer of their device, during which any manufacturing defects that may out will also be repaired.

Insurance

Students are responsible for the care of the device while at school as they are their property. We suggest parents check with their insurance companies to check their level of cover. While some contents insurance packages automatically include devices away from home, others require additional cover.

Device Specifications

Wireless connectivity - Devices must support 5GhZ dual band, 802.11 a/b/g/n wireless.

Memory – Devices must have a minimum of 128GB storage and 4GB RAM. Keyboard, camera and microphone - are recommended for students to participate in 21st Century Learning.

Screen size - must be at least 10 diagonal inches.

Battery - must be able to exceed 8 hours of usage time.

Mouse—please ensure your child has a mouse.

Software and Applications (Devices must be loaded with Internet browsing software)



RESIDENTIAL Requirements



General Clothing

Neat and tidy casual clothes Sneakers (non-marking sole - for use in gym) General footwear

Bathers

Underwear

Shoe polish

Toiletrey requisites (no aerosols are to be bought onto College grounds)

Dorm Room

- 2 towels
- 2 sets of king single sheets (compulsory)
- 2 pillowcases (compulsory)
- 1 rug/doona or 2 blankets (compulsory)
- 1 pillow
- 1 laundry pen (essential for new clothes and worn markings)
- 2 washing bags (to keep socks and underwear together)

Coat hangers

King single mattress protector (compulsory)

Sleeping bag/swag (for camping - not permissible in dormitories)

Pin up Board Pins (as nothing can be fixed to the walls and doors by tape, blue tack etc)

Whilst students take their laundry to the commercial laundry onsite, they are able to wash their small items in the dorm washing machines. Students are to bring laundry powder to do so.



DAY Requirements



Day students attend the College only during instructional hours but do have access to all curriculum and associated activities.

Overview

- They are obliged to conform to the requirements of the College Handbook and the College Code of Behaviour, including uniforms.
- · Sign in and out of the campus at the Administration Office.
- Will have "visitor status" outside the hours of their course of study.

Uniform

- Wear the College uniform.
- All uniforms are to be clearly marked with name and day student number.
- They are expected to arrive at the College neatly and presentably, including wearing the correct uniform and polished boots.
- Day students are ambassadors of the College; therefore, outside of instructional times, Day students need to behave accordingly whilst in uniform and wear it in the appropriate manner so as to not bring the College and its reputation into disrepute.

Access / Transport To and From the College

- Arrive at the College not more than half an hour before classes or activities and leave after completion of classes or associated activities unless otherwise authorised.
- Students arriving late must report to the Administration office for a late note.
- May apply to drive a vehicle to the College each day and park in the designated area. The Application Form is to be completed and approval is to be given before bringing a vehicle on site.
- Student Car Park is out of bounds to all students during the instructional day.
- May not transport other students without authorisation from the Administration and the respective parent/guardian consent.

Facility Access

- · Are not permitted in residential dormitory areas.
- Must use allocated shower and toilet facilities in the gymnasium.
- Students are to use the gymnasium change rooms to get changed, NOT the Day student room. Personal items must be stored in designated areas.
- Lockers are available in the "Day Student Room" in the gymnasium area and a phone locker is available outside the Administration office.

DAY Requirements

Dairy / Morning Milking / Weekend Stock

- Day students are required to fulfill their dairy duties.
- Failure to do so will result in a change of status, which will affect their ability to be involved in school activities, i.e. excursions, shows etc.
 They will remain on this status until they complete their dairy duties. It also affects their ability to achieve competency completion in this section as they have not demonstrated the minimum requirement.
- May be invited or can apply to stay overnight when required for morning dairy duties, or other activities requiring an early departure or late return. This is only available should accommodation be available. All residential conditions apply in this instance.

Day Student Number

- Each new student will receive a unique Day student number that they will keep throughout their time at the College.
- Students will be issued two sets of boot tags with this number, which will be placed on both pairs of boots.
- Please ensure that all school clothes are identified with this number.

Padlock

- Day students are required to bring a large lock for their daily locker.
- A small lock for their phone locker (which is located outside the back of the administration office).
